### 30 Day Notice

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Interested parties are hereby notified that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), Portland District, proposes to relocate and realign a portion of an existing access road at Foster Dam and Reservoir in Linn County, Oregon. The proposed plan will close and restore a 580 linear foot section of existing roadway along a portion of the dam access road and construct a 400 linear foot section of road. The project will improve access to Foster Lake for motor vehicles, bicycles, and pedestrians.

**Environmental Documents:** A draft Environmental Assessment addressing the impacts associated with the activity is enclosed for public review and comment. The draft is also available on the Corps website at [www.nwp.usace.army.mil/pm/e](http://www.nwp.usace.army.mil/pm/e)

**State Water Quality Certification:** The proposed project is in compliance with the Clean Water Act. A National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System construction storm water permit under Section 402 will be required. There will be no fill in waters of the United States.
