Wetland A	0.48	acre(s)	(b)(1) Non-adjacent wetland.	Wetland A is a palustrine forest/scrub-shrub wetland. The wetland does extend outside of the Review Area; However, the site is bordered by roads, residential developments, and rail line. Based on review of Google Earth Pro aerial imagery, topographic maps, and the National Hydrography Dataset there are no (a)(1)-(a)(3) waters within or near the vicinity of the Review Area. Wetland A does not directly abut an (a)(1)- (a)(3) water, as it is surrounded by uplands. There is no evidence Wetland A is inundated by flooding in a typical year nor separated from an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water only by a natural feature. Furthermore, this wetland is not separated from an (a)(1)-(a)(3) water only by an artificial structure allowing a direct hydrologic surface connection between the wetlands and the (a)(1)-(a)(3) water in a typical year. Wetland A does not meet the definition of an adjacent wetland under the NWPR.
