

## TRANSITION TO ACASS/CCASS MODERNIZED SYSTEMS

The transition to the Contractor Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS) host computer has been completed.

The modernized systems were implemented on 5 October, 2005. The modernized ACASS/CCASS systems are now available for use. The web address for the modernized systems is located at <http://www.cpars.navy.mil/>

The US Army Corps of Engineers remains the Authorized Agent for ACASS and CCASS, and the Portland District Contractor Appraisal Information Center (CAIC) continues to support both government personnel and contractors in using these systems.

Access to the modernized ACASS/CCASS systems begins with the appointment of a "Focal Point" at each major command, district, or branch office. The Focal Point is the person who grants access to all other ACASS/CCASS users within their local command.

Note: Focal Points have access to all three systems, ACASS, CCASS and CPARS.

Designated Focal Points may apply for access by filling out the "Access Request Form."
