ANNUAL FISH PASSAGE REPORT (RCS NWDCM-79)

**History.** This issue is a revision of the original form of NPDR 1110-2-1 to bring it in line with the restructuring of Northwestern Division.

**Summary.** This regulation on the annual reporting of fish passage facilities is revised to update the information and references due to the restructuring of the Northwestern Division (NWD) and changes the Report Control Symbol (RCS) office designation.

1. PURPOSE. This report is designed to provide elements of the Division responsible for planning, design, and operation of fish passage facilities with essential data for performance of assigned functions. It will also provide vital information to other Federal, State and local agencies legally responsible for preservation of the fisheries resources. The report will include appropriate information collected at all projects in the Northwestern Division where fish count data are assembled.
2. APPLICABILITY. This regulation is applicable only to the Portland and Walla Walla Districts who are responsible for preparation of Annual Fish Passage Reports (RCS NWDCM-79).
3. GENERAL. An annual report will be prepared which consolidates and summarizes into one publication, information, data, and statistics which have accumulated as a result of fish passage counts, special studies, and operation of fish passage facilities installed on projects operated by Northwestern Division within the Columbia Basin. Data will include brief texts summarizing current tests or studies, tables, charts, and plates relative to fish passage and counting operations, flowage conditions, and weather.



4. **PROCEDURE.** The report will be consolidated and published by Portland District. Walla Walla District information and data for the report will be furnished the Portland District not later than 15 March. The report will be published and available for distribution not later than 15 May of the year following the collection of fish passage and related data.
