SAFETY AND OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH POLICIES

NPDR 385-1-1, 1 March 1992, is supplemented as follows:

Page 1, paragraph 1. Purpose. Add to paragraph 1:

Any written request, with Portland District, for waiver, modification or rescinding a portion(s) of this regulation will be made in consultation with the District Safety Office, through the District Commander, to higher authority as appropriate.

Page 1, paragraph 2. Applicability. Add to paragraph 2:

Individuals responsible for management, supervision, and inspection are expected to comply with this regulation and its references in every operation (government or contract) for which they are responsible. Full and complete responsibility for the consistent application of accident prevention and enforcement of safety provisions rests with the government supervisor(s) in charge of the work. In a staff capacity, the Safety Office shall evaluate safety activities and provide safety engineering and safety management advisory service. Division, Branch and Office Chiefs, Dredge Masters, Area Engineers, Resident Engineers and Project Managers will ensure that supervisors, managers and inspectors are familiar with governing regulations that provide basic instructions in administering the District's safety and occupational health program.

Page 1, paragraph 3. References. Add subparagraph to Appendix A, paragraph A-1.w.:

w. PDR/NPPR 385 series


