OFFICIAL BULLETIN BOARDS

History. This NPPR printing publishes a revision of this regulation.

Summary. This regulation identifies what material may be posted on official bulletin boards. The proponent is now from Headquarters, North Pacific Division because of the integration of the Information Management Offices. Bulletin boards are a function of Information Management, thus the proponent.

1. PURPOSE. To provide guidance in establishment and maintenance of bulletin boards as authorized media for communicating with employees.

2. APPLICABILITY. This regulation is applicable to all organizational elements of Portland District (NPP).

3. RELATED REFERENCE. Title 41, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 101-20.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES.

a. Offices assigned permanent space on bulletin boards will review posted material quarterly to ensure all information is current and correct.

*b. Within the Robert Duncan Plaza, offices not assigned permanent space on bulletin boards will forward items for posting to CENPD-IM-R.

5. MATERIAL ELIGIBLE FOR POSTING. The following types of notices or information bulletins may be posted on bulletin boards.

a. Official business notices.

*This regulation supersedes NPPR 1-1-52, 2 May 1991.

b. Requests for funds for welfare, health and other purposes approved by the District Commander.

c. Notices to federal employees by concessionaires and agency employee groups or organizations recognized by the Corps.

d. Personal notices of Corps employees such as sale of an employee's home, and requests for carpool participation.
