Term and Conditions 3i

3. In order to minimize the likelihood of incidental take associated with uncertainty and risk regarding long-term Project effects, the Corps shall implement a monitoring program with the following elements:
 - i In the event the Project will use ocean disposal at the Deep Water Site (see Section 3.2.8 of the 2001 BA), the management plan for this disposal site will be coordinated with NMFS.
 - i. NMFS will be notified of and invited to all Ocean Dredged Material Disposal Site Taskforce meetings.
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Action Plan: The Record of Decision specifies that construction material will go to an ocean disposal site due to the Oregon state approvals for Water Quality and Coastal Zone Consistency. In the event beneficial use is allowed or encouraged by the state in the future, this decision could be revisited. The beneficial use of dredged material at Lois Island embayment was supported by the Services and consulted on.

The ocean dredged material site task force was disbanded as documented in the Final Supplemental EIS 2003. The Corps is actively pursuing the collaborative process on regional sediment management in the lower river and NOAA Fisheries and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service will be involved.

The Deep Water (DWS) and Shallow Water Site SMMP were provided to NOAA and USFWS in January 2004 for review and comment. No comments were received from the agencies.

The DWS was used in 2005 to place material dredged from the CRCIP below RM 29.

Schedule: If in the future material from the CRCIP needs to go to the DWS, NOAA and USFWS will be notified.
