4. The Corps shall implement an adaptive management process to review results of the monitoring program and other applicable new information and determine actions necessary to minimize any adverse Project effect:
  - h. The Corps shall ensure that development and implementation of the adaptive management process is consistent with Action Items 158, 159, 161, and 163 of the FCRPS Hydropower biological opinion (December, 2000).

**Action Plan:** The Corps has reviewed FCRPS Action Items, 158, 159, 161 and 163 and will ensure that the plan developed by the contract is consistent with these items. The Corps has instituted an internal team of technical individuals that meet on a regular basis to ensure that there is consistency between the Biops. Blaine Ebberts is the Corps Project Manager.

**Schedule:** The Federal Columbia River Power System Action Items, 158, 159, 161 and 163 have been superseded and under examination by the court. However, the Corps has instituted an internal team of technical individuals that meet on a regular basis to ensure the intent is consistent between this Biological Opinion (BiOp) and any new hydropower BiOp.
