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Interested parties are hereby notified that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), Portland District, proposes the restoration of historic drainage patterns and wetlands near Parker Lane at the Dexter Dam Project in Lane County, Oregon. The proposed action will reconnect an existing stormwater drainage ditch to a natural swale. This action will restore and enhance wetlands and reduce or eliminate flooding events at the nearby City of Lowell water treatment facility.
