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Interested parties are hereby notified that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Portland District, proposes to provide restoration to about 7.5 miles of Columbia Slough by deepening the slough, creating 9 acres of wetland benches, replacing five culverts and restoring adjacent 18 acres of wetland, in Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon. This action is proposed in conjunction with other restoration activities performed by the City of Portland and Multnomah County Drainage District No. 1.

**Environmental Documents:** A draft Environmental Assessment addressing the impacts associated with the activity is enclosed for public review and comment as part of the draft environmental restoration report.

**State Water Quality Certification:** State Water Quality Certification, pursuant to Section 401 of the Clean Water Act, is hereby being requested from the State of Oregon, Department of Environmental Quality. A 404 (b) (1) Evaluation (Appendix C of the report) and State of Oregon public notice are enclosed.

**Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972:** The project location is outside the Coastal Zone.
